Girls Incorporated "Herstory"

Girls Incorporated® (formerly Girls Club of Owensboro-Daviess County) was founded in 1969 through the efforts of the Junior Woman's Club and community leaders. With humble beginnings in a small apartment in 1970, the organization has been a growing establishment in the community ever since. In 1980, Girls Incorporated® moved into its current home – Baltzer Hall. In 1990, Girls Clubs of America changed its name to Girls Incorporated® and all local affiliates followed suit, thus establishing the current name – Girls Incorporated® of Owensboro-Daviess County. The year of 1999 brought major improvements to Girls Incorporated®: the Patty Rayburn Annex was added to Baltzer Hall, and a second location opened at Settle Memorial United Methodist Church. In 2004, the Settle Memorial UMC location transferred to its current location at First Christian Church for the after-school program, and summers take place at the Owensboro Community & Technical College.

Sports & Adventure: Enables girls to compete and cooperate with confidence, to take physical risks, and to master a range of physical skills.

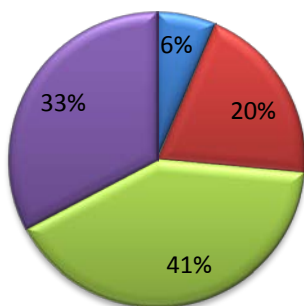

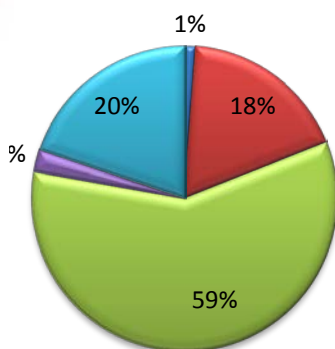
2010 Member Demographics

Age



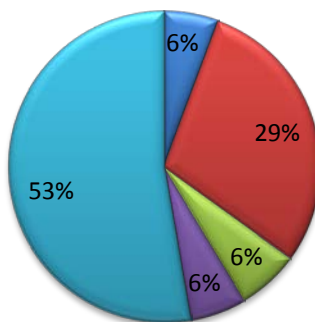

Racial / Ethnic Profile



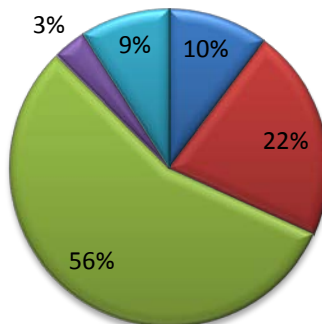

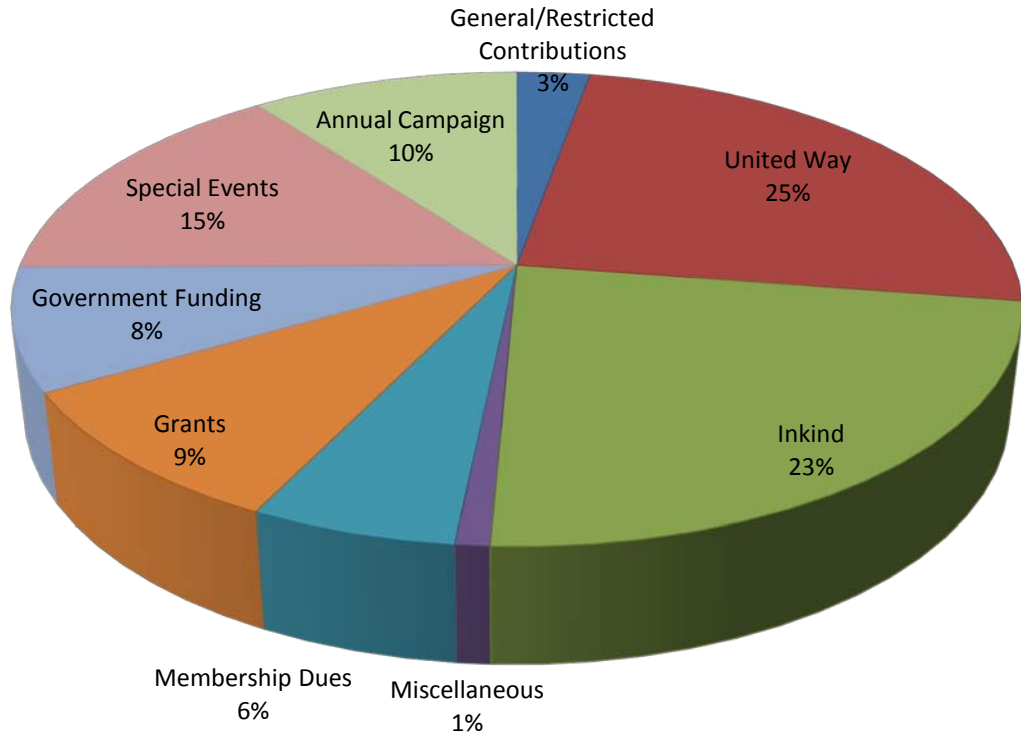

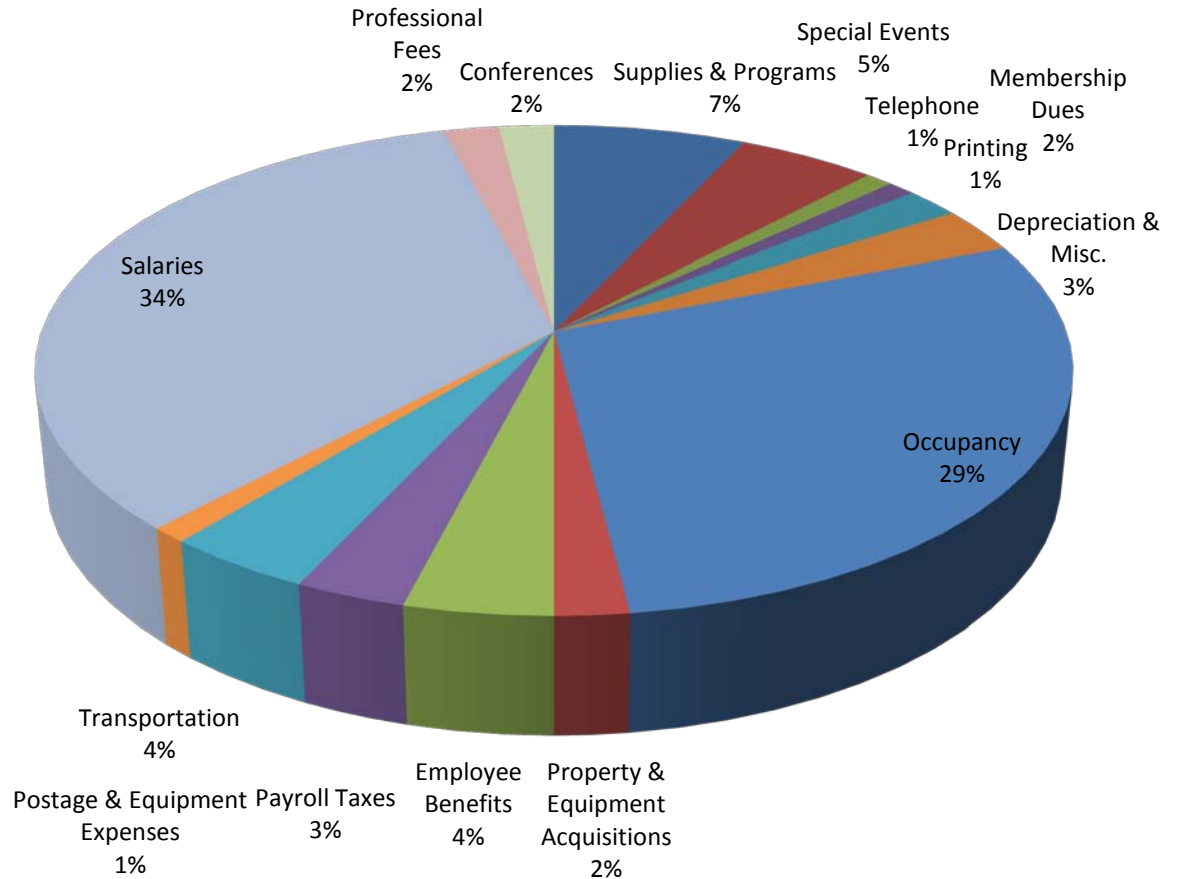
